



Corded Poles and Tracks

British and European standard BSEN13120

As of 28th February 2014 the BSEN13120 Standard was implemented to tackle the issues surrounding child fatalities and injuries linked to window coverings, with the UK seeing the highest figures.

The BSEN13120 Standard covers internal blinds only, however, the European Commission made a decision to extend the scope of this new law to incorporate other types of window coverings normally excluded from the standard as they still pose a threat to child safety – this includes corded poles and tracks.

Information required for Orders and Quotations

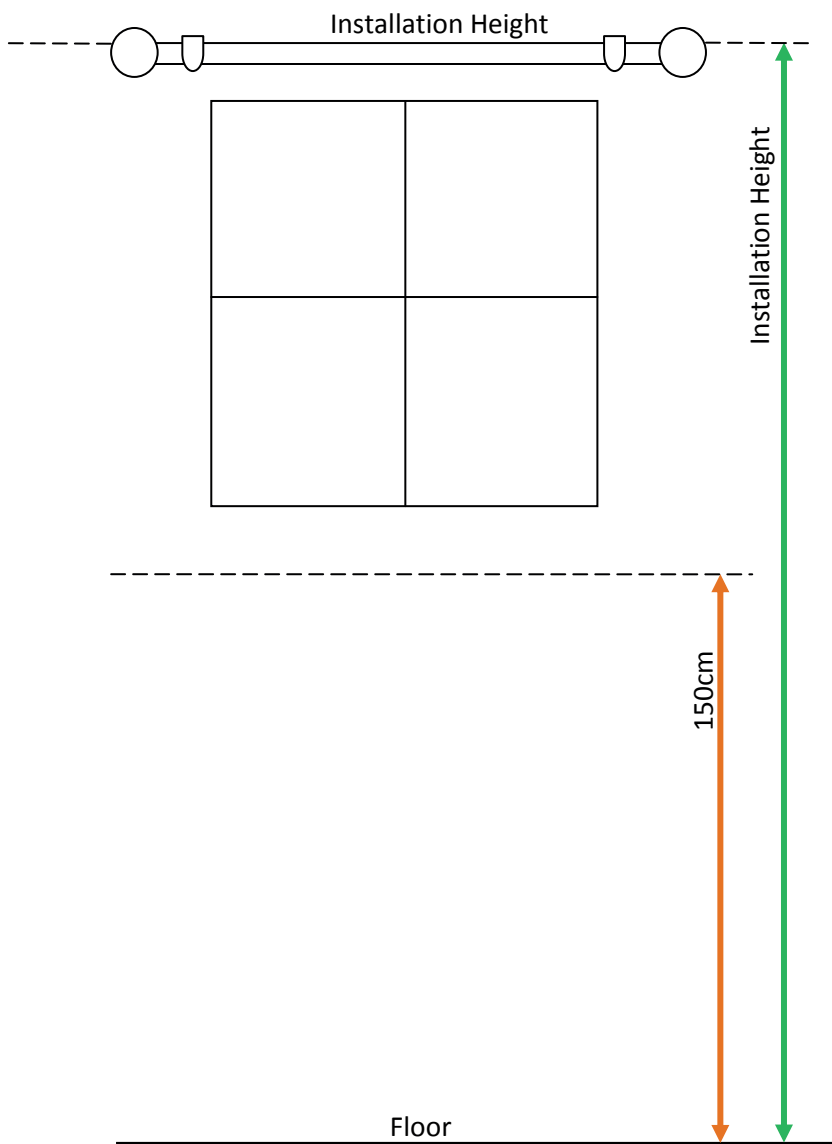
If you wish to purchase any drapery product that requires a cording system from Byron & Byron, it is your duty to assist us to comply with this new law.

At the time of taking an order or quotation, we will ask for the installation height so that we are able to calculate the cord drop. We are unable to supply a cord drop longer than 1 meter if the installation height is not provided. **We will not deviate from this under any circumstances.**

If the installation height is provided the cord drop will finish at least 1.5m away from the floor, therefore tension pulleys etc can no longer be fitted to skirting boards.



Please look at the drawing below and fill in the form below so that we, to the best our abilities, can calculate the maximum length of the cord allowed based on the measurements provided.



If the installation height is not provided, the pole/track will be supplied with a 1m cord drop as standard.

Where the installation height has been provided the cord will be calculated to be no less than 150cm from the floor.

Example: Installation height 4.0m – 1.5m = 2.5m cord drop
